



Situate in York Township in the County of York and containing as above set forth 43 acres 1/2 perches & allowance being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the 3<sup>rd</sup> mo. 1772 by William Kersey - late U.S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Michael Hamilka - bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1771 - Divided off from the said larger tract on the 25<sup>th</sup> of 5<sup>th</sup> mo. 1792 by William Kersey late U.S. and now after having been carefully examined corrected and calculated it is at the Request of the present owner Francis Groff, returned for Confirmation the 2<sup>d</sup> day of August A.D. 1809.
