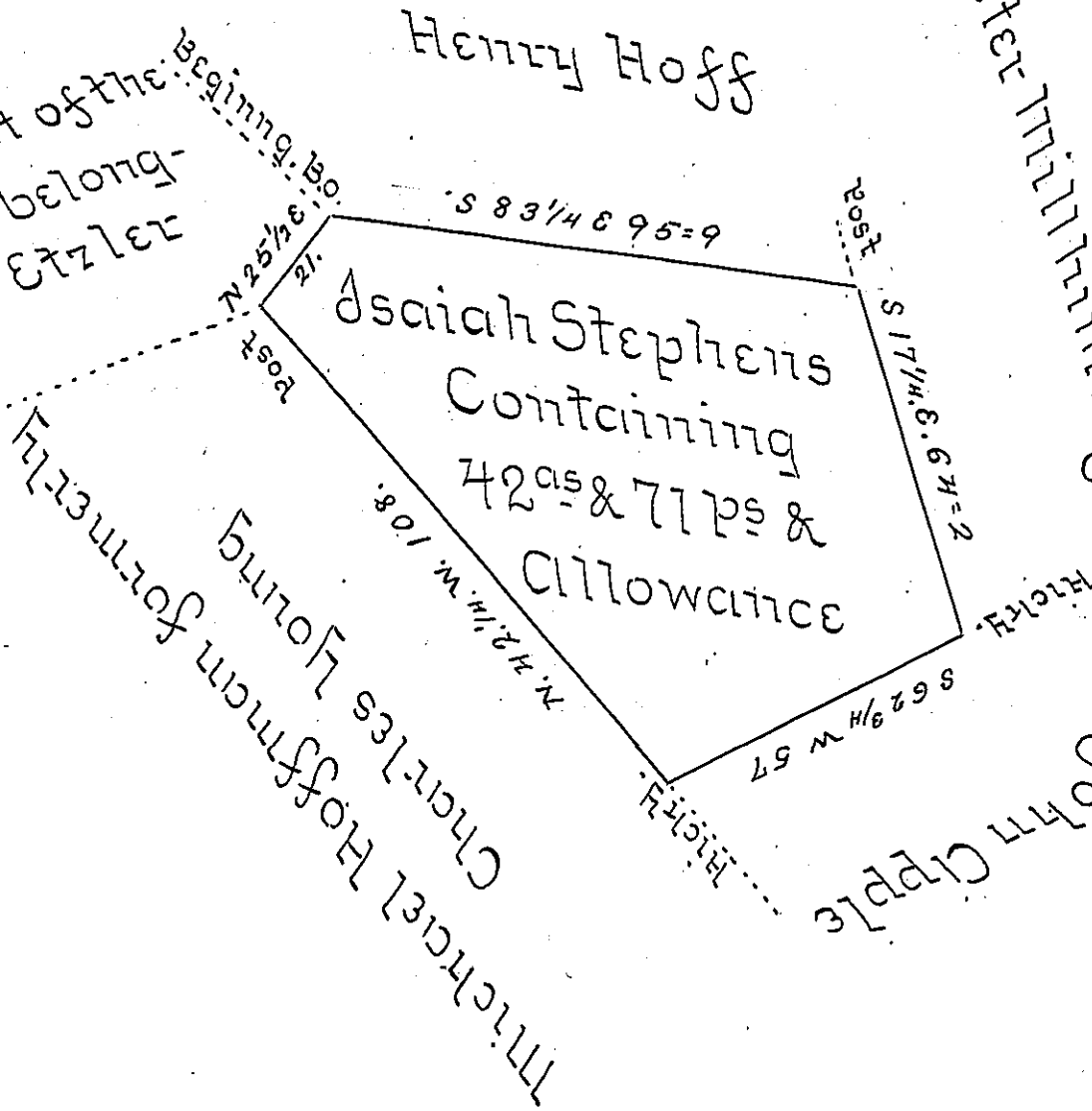


The other part of the
