



By virtue of a Warrant granted to Henry Peters dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 1752 Resurveyed & divided off for Abraham Henry on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1806 twenty four Acres & a half & allowance as also by an Entry in the Secretaries Warrant Book 17 page 713 date the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1771 thirty seven acres & one hundred & twenty six perches & allowance Being parts of two Original Surveys on the above Warrant & Entry Containing together sixty two acres & forty six perches & allowance Situate in (Berry) now Bondowerry Township Dauphin County
