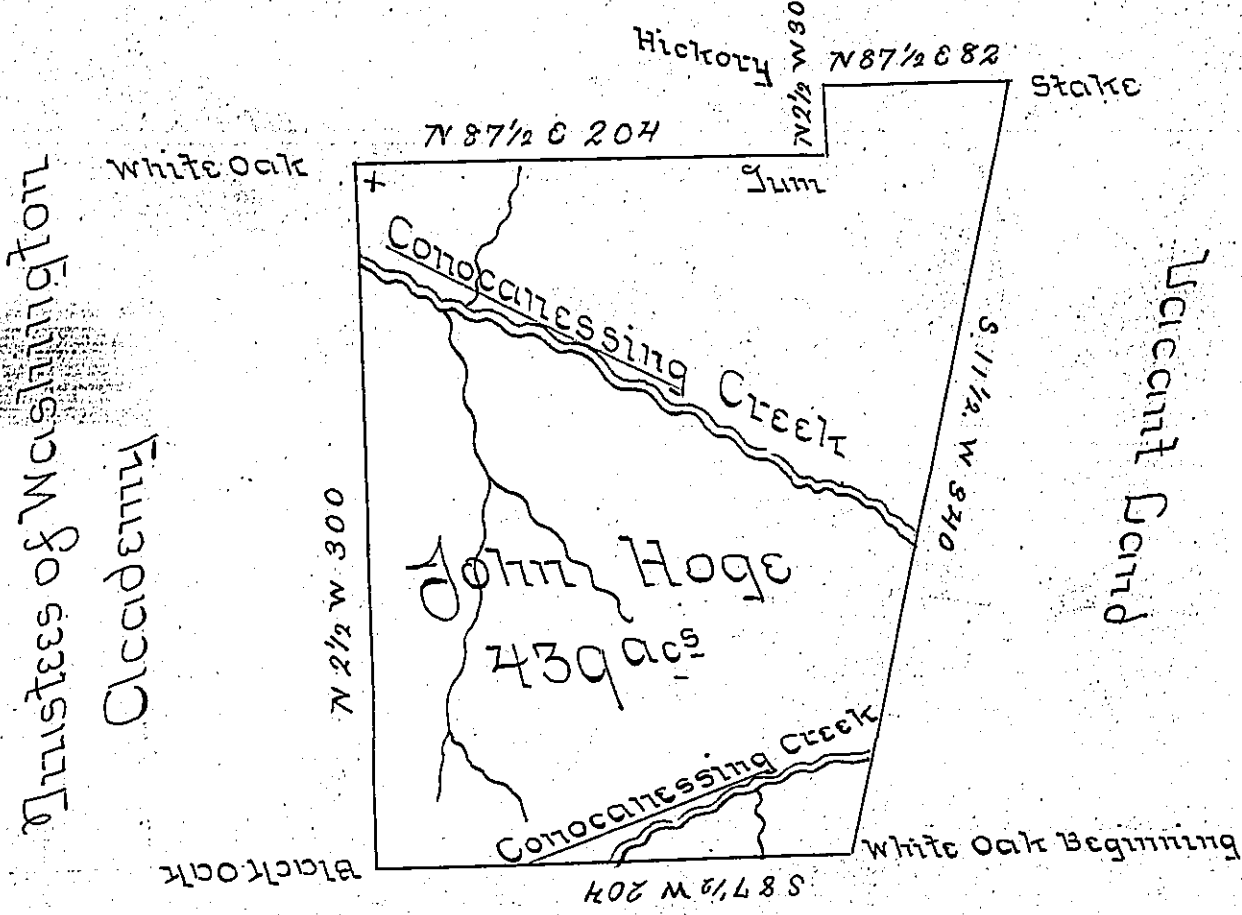

A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed November the 16th day 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Hoge for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th day of December in the Year 1792 Situate North and West of the River Ohio Allegany and Conawango Creek about two Miles below Brush Creek on the Conocanessing and about one Mile above Slippery Rock to include the Great Falls above the Mouth of Slippery Rock on the Conocanessing Creek and the Big Bend Called Great Falls Containing four hundred and thirty nine Acres together with the usual Allowance of Six P^{er} C^{ent} for Roads
