



Situate in Union township Huntingdon County Originally Surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1775. in pursuance of an Order of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 2266. dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1766. Resurveyed for M. F. Campbell the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October 1865. I find that part of Gideon Miller's survey is covered by a Survey in name of John Bayles 436<sup>as</sup> W<sup>t</sup> dated 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan 1794. and John Bell 385 as. 44 P<sup>s</sup> W<sup>t</sup> dated 5<sup>th</sup> March 1794. The part of Gideon Miller inclosed by black lines is clear of interference and contains one hundred one acres one hundred eighteen perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
