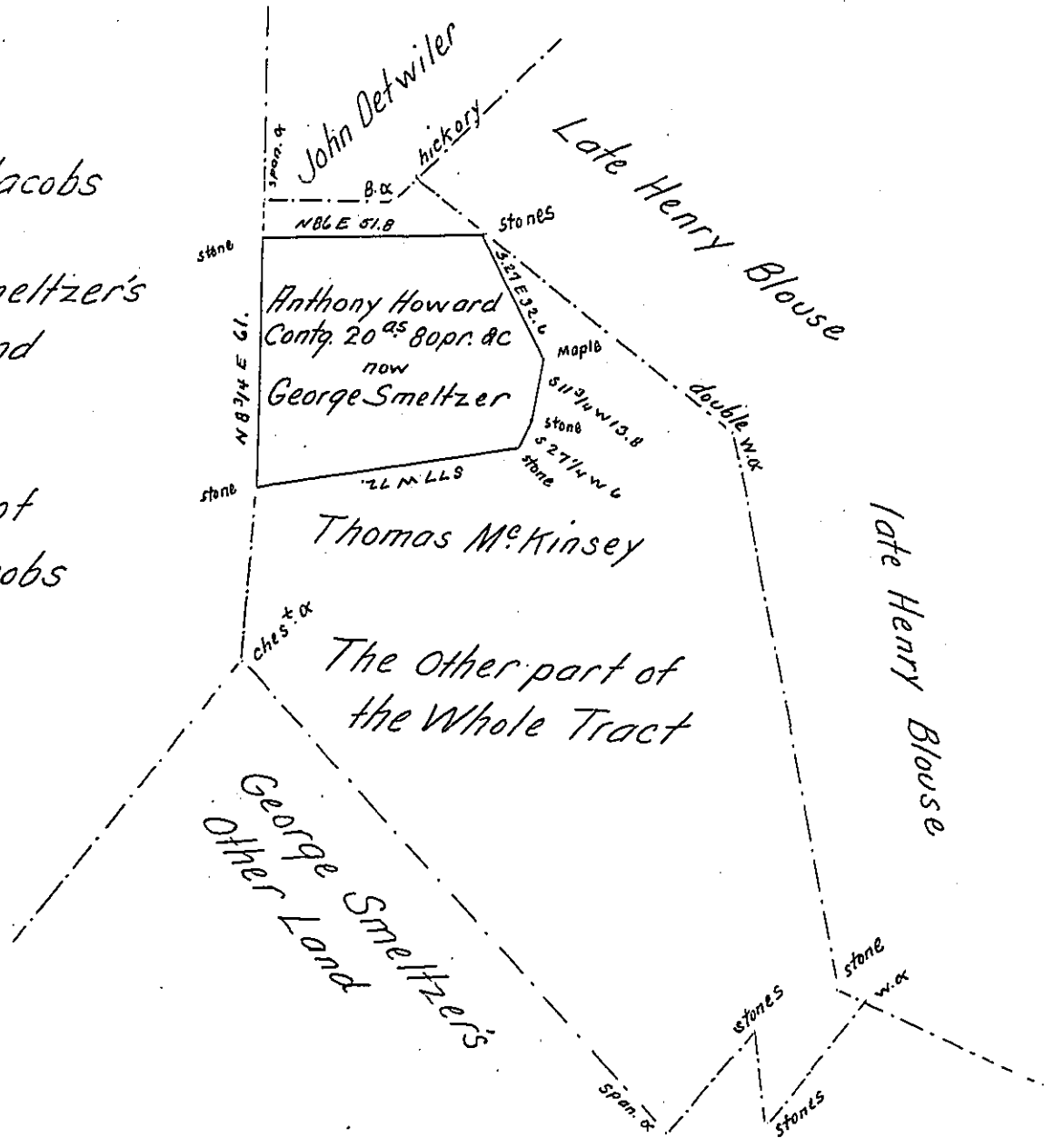

Which was Originally Surveyed on the 11th of the 5th mo. 1793. in pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{as} dated the 11th January 1793. granted to Anthony Howard. and having since been resurveyed &c. And now on the 8th day of September 1864. been requested by George Smeltzer the present Owner to make return of the same who wishes to patent the same &c.
