Containing Seventy one acres and one hundred and forty three perch and the usual allowance of six per centum for Roads &c. Surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract in 1863 by William Crotsley and Reexamined and found correct the 3^d day of August A.D. 1869 for Samuel M^e Lainper.
