



Situate on the north side of the West branch of Susquehanna River, adjoining lands of John Ferguson, an improvement of David Ferguson and others; including an Improvement made by Joseph Hutchinson since January or February 1805 in Clearfield County chimdiclarnush township; containing Four hundred and Forty acres and allowance for roads &c.

Surveyed the 2^d October 1810 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jasen Kirk assignee of Joseph Hutchinson and dated 26th of June 1810
