



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Barbara Kline bearing date the seventh day August 1811 Survey'd on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September following unto the aforesaid Barbara Kline the above discribed tract of land containing one acre and forty four perches and nine tenths of a perch and allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c.

Including hir improvement thereon consisting of a Dwelling house and about one acre of land cleared and fenced Situate in Hempfield Township in the County of Westmoreland First commenced to be improven in the beginning of March 1800
