



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number forty Seven. Containing in Breadth East and West on Shamokin Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Southward by Shamokin Street aforesaid Eastward by Lot Number forty Six, Northward by Mulberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number forty Eight. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January 1775 for John Keble by Warrant dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January 1775.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of July 1905.
