



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Jane McCarrell on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and forty Two Contain^g in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Poakberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and forty one, Northward by Gooseberry Alley & Westward by Lot Number Two Hundred and forty three. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 27th day of February 1776 for George Keiser by Warrant dated the 23^d day of said Month and Year.
