



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Jacob Eicholtz on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred & four Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and Three, Northward by Strawberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and five. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1776 for Lodowick Kass by Warrant dated the 20<sup>th</sup> of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this tenth day of August 1905.
