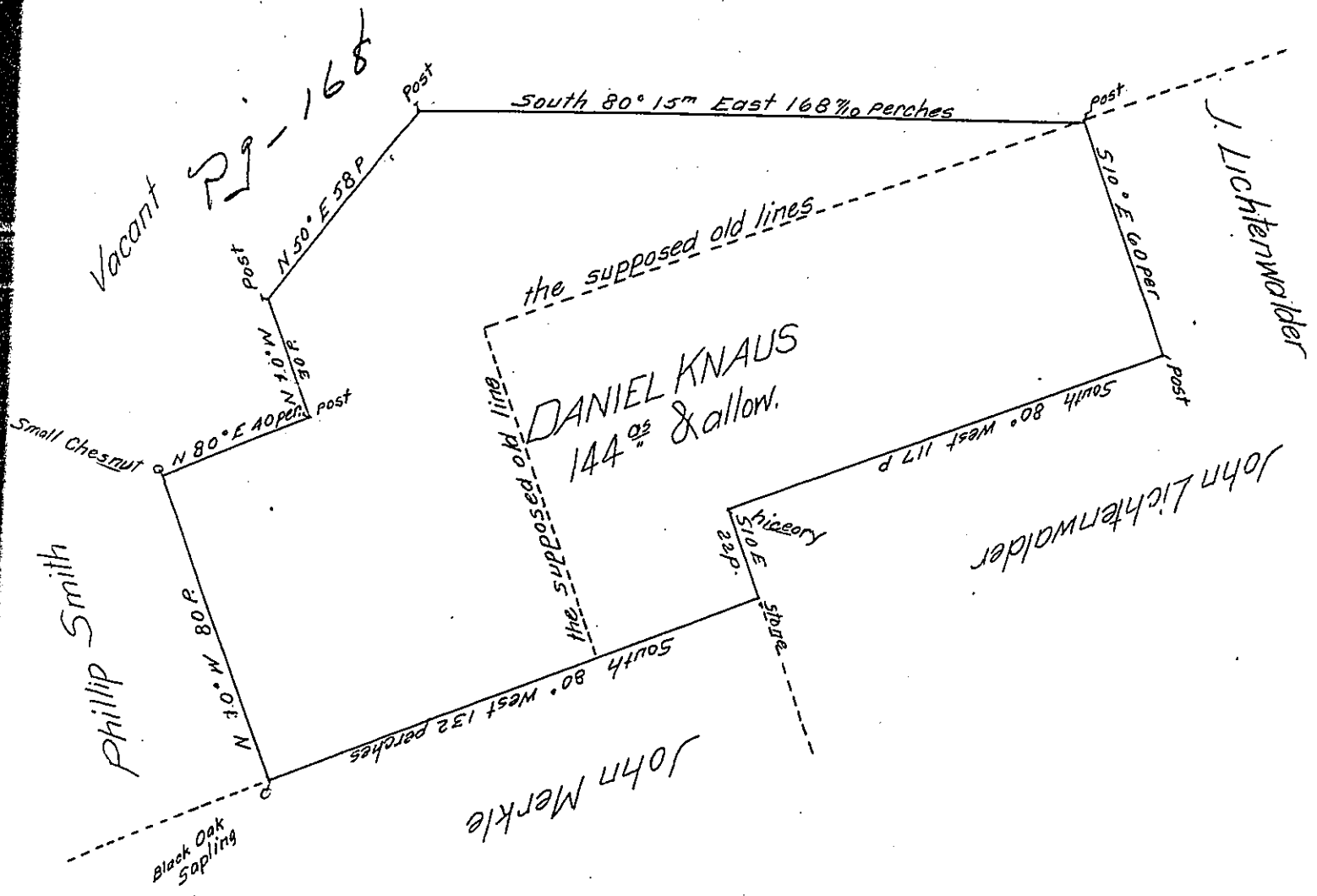


Vacant



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 21st Day of July Anno. 1755, granted to Daniel Knaus, (alias Knowse). Part of the above described Tract of Land Situate in Weisenbergh Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing together with a Track of about 50 or Sixty acres, more or less, That was formerly Surveyed to Peter Terr (of which said Tract, Two old Lines were no more to be found, and therefore were obliged to Survey both Tracts together) one hundred and forty four Acres of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Road, was Surveyed for the said Daniel Knaus on the 26th Day of May Anno 1757. By Order of Mr. William Parsons Esquire.
