



A Draught of a Tract of Land  
 situate in Berwick Township in the County of York Resurveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794 to Henry Kuhn by the lines formerly run by Charles Lukens late Dy. Surveyor in

pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey granted to Frederick Kuhn dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of September 1769 containing in the whole Two Hundred and fifty five acres and a half and allowance of six acres p Cent for Roads.

N.B. The part where the letter A is placed Contains one Hundred and fifty six acres and allowance - and the part where B is placed Contains Ninety Nine Acres & a half & allowance being part of land granted John Oliver by his Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1752
