



Situated in Huntington Township Adams County containing 38<sup>a</sup> 85<sup>p</sup> and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads and Highways. It being a part of a larger tract said to contain 166<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acres originally surveyed by Geo Smith D.S. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joshua Kenworthy for 100 acres dated May 11<sup>th</sup> 1743. Surveyed and divided as above described January 14<sup>th</sup> 1837 By David McMillan D.S. To John Taylor Esq<sup>r</sup> Sy or General.
