



A Draught of a Tract of

Land situate in Guilford Township

Franklin County, in two parts, containing in the whole one hundred and thirty four Acres and ninety perches & allowance of six percent for roads &c. being parts of a larger tract of 319 Acres 52 perches Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Jack bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> January 1753.

The above parts were Surveyed and divided off 22 Dec<sup>r</sup> 1820 (by Archibald Fleming then D. Surveyor) as purparts No 1 and No 2 in the division of the Estate of Peter Snider dec<sup>d</sup> as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in the D. Surveyors Office
