



Situate on the head waters of Juniotta in Greenfield Township Bedford County Containing 437<sup>95</sup> & allowance of Six Per Ct. for Roads &c. first Surveyed in the year 1794 in persuance of a Warrant granted to Benjamin John - dated 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794 but not returned Resurveyed under the directions of James Piper Esq. late D.S. the 8<sup>th</sup> day of April 1830 & Returned into the Surveyor Generals Office the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1830 But on Examination it appears not to table Examined & corrected by the original field notes the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>ry</sup> 1831.
