Beginning at a white oak a Corner of Francis Gandevitts land thence by land of John Hendrick Snider South west one hundred and Six perches to a post in the line of Johanna Freds land thence by that of Vacant land North West Two hundred and forty perches to a post thence by Vacant land North East one hundred & six perches to a post thence by Vacant land South East one hundred & thirty four perches & by land of sd Francis Gandevitt the same Course one hundred & six perches to ye place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres with usual allowance
