



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Sept 13th 1826 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Jackman, for twenty acres of land, dated August 15th 1826, but Contains twenty Acres and 56 perches and Allowance of six per Cent for highways, situate on the waters of Pike Run, in Pike Run Township, W. County. At the time of Survey, there was a small improvement ^{on the above} (about two Acres) there had been a Cabin but it is gone.
