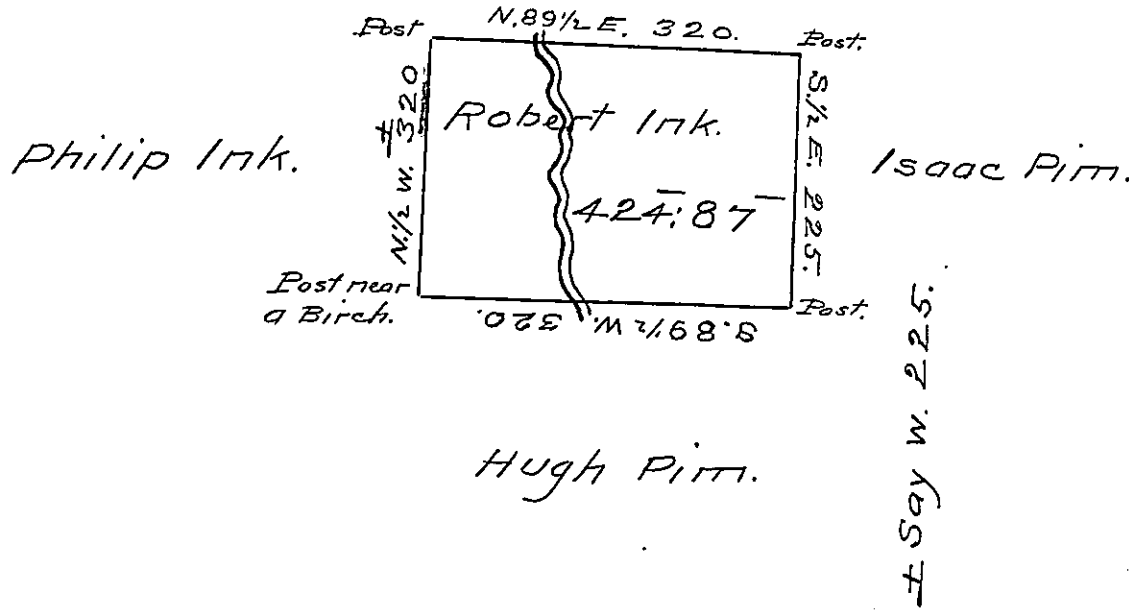


Jacob Ink.

 Creek in District No 1 surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June  
 1799 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of  
 and a warrant of the Surveyor Genl. (upon an order of the Board of Property) Dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799.  
 Robert Ink dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1793. Con-  
 taining four hundred & twenty four acres & Eighty  
 seven perches and the Allowance of six per Cent.
