



The above is a Draught of a survey made June 27th 1826 in pursuance of a warrant, granted to William Jackson, for Five acres, but contains eighteen acres, and eighty two perches, and allowance of six pr Cent for highways, situate on the waters of Kings Creek Hanover Township W. C. The first improvement made in 1825. The warrant dated March 6th 1826
