



In pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Kirkwood dated the twenty-first day of December 1810, Surveyed on the 16th of October following, unto the aforesaid Thomas Kirkwood, the above described tract of Land containing two hundred & thirteen acres and one hundred & fifty five perches & Nin-tenths of a perch with an Allowance, proportioned at Six per Cent for roads &c.

Situate on the water of Pike run adjoining lands of Hugh Conaway, James Hall, John Erwin, John Jamison, and others in Washington Township (1810) the County of Westmoreland. Including An improvement there on consisting of A Dwelling House & Barn & about Forty acres of land cleared &c. First Commenced to be improved in the Beginning of March A.D. 1795.
