



In pursuance of an order N<sup>o</sup> 2792, dated the thirteenth day of February 1767, surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1767 for Joseph Price, the above described Tract of Land situate Northward of the Frankstown branch of Juniata—a few Miles above a Creek, known by the name of Water Street, in the County of Cumberland, containing Three Hundred and eleven acres, and a half and the usual allowance of six acres of C<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c.
