Dom. 1815,  $\frac{1}{2}$  Simon Snyder, Esq<sup>r</sup> late Deputy Surveyor, for Christopher Kline, Sen<sup>r</sup> in pursuance of his Warrant bearing Date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August A. Dom. 1814.
