



Draft of twenty five acres, and one hundred and twenty seven perches of land with six per cent for roads. Situate in Union township, in Mifflin county, surveyed 18th-March 1814, for Joseph Kyle then held by him, said Kyle, by his improvement of a house, and an acre of ground in grain, whose right to the same is now, 13th-July 1816, vested in Jacob King, examined on the ground the said 13th-July 1816, for the said Jacob King in pursuance of his Warrant dated 13th-June 1816. Note said improvement was made in April 1811.
