



Situate on the waters of Pound Lick run, including an improvement first begun the first Day of March 1802, in Milford Township, Somerset County, & Surveyed the 23<sup>rd</sup> Day of December 1818. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1817, and is returned for the owner to comply with the Act to authorize the Officers of the Land Office to accept returns of Surveys and direct patents to issue, where an excess of more than ten per Cent, is returned, passed the thirteenth Day of March 1817."
