Bounded Westward with Beaver Street aforesaid Southward with a Twenty Feet Alley Eastward with a Twenty Feet Alley and Northward with a Lot of Ground marked on the Plan aforesaid Number eighty three, formerly surveyed and laid out for Baltzer Knertzer who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the said Town
