 thence by the same South East Sixty Two perches to a Black Oak  
 and by land of Martin Hildeboidle seventy perches to a post thence  
 by land of ye sd<sup>d</sup> Hildeboidle South West one hundred & forty six  
 perches to a large Hickry markt for a Corner & the same course  
 by the land of Christopher Duck Twenty six perches to ye place of  
 Beginning. Containing one hundred and thirty four acres with usual  
 Allowance

 Young by General Orders & before sd<sup>d</sup> Devald applied for a Warr<sup>t</sup> he  
 sells all his claim to John Isaac Clize who obtained a Warr<sup>t</sup> in his own  
 name dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of 10 ber 1734 In pursuance whereof I have Returned the  
 same into the Secretary's Office the 19<sup>th</sup> of 10 ber 1734.
