



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Lower Milford Township in the County of Bucks, in the State of Pennsylvania containing Seventy one Acres and 148 perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly surveyed to Philip Kuhnius by Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries dated on 22^d April Anno 1740 the said Kuhnius sold the same on Decemb^r 12th 1748 to Rudolph Frick, and he again on the 22^d January 1768 to Benjamin Sommer who on the 19th January 1775 sold the same to Philip Sholl who died May 24th 1783, whose Executors Geo Wickard Sholl and Peter, sold now the greatest part as 67^a thereof to W^m Jameson and the Remainder to Frederick Wambold the whole was Resurveyed and divided on the 5th August Anno 1783.
