



The above is a draught of a survey made Feb<sup>y</sup>. 9<sup>th</sup> 1833 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Kintner, John Onstott, and George Miller and their successors in trust for the use of the German Lutheran and Calvinist Congregations for 25 acres and 63 perches strict measure dated Jan<sup>y</sup>. 15<sup>th</sup> 1816 Containing sixteen acres and twenty five perches strict measure being all that is left clear of older and better titles Situate in Somerset Township Washington County on the waters of Pigeon Creek
