



The above draft represents a survey made the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March 1833 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Knight dated February the 25<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1833 for one hundred and five acres situate in Ohio town-ship Beaver County <sup>adjoining</sup> lands of David Knight on the south Samuel Ewing's on the North George Mason on the West & John Chamberlin and John Knight Junr. on the East containing one hundred and fifteen acres and the usual allowance
