



May 10th 1836 I John Martin D.S. in and for the County of Beaver surveyed the above described land for John Knight Junr and John Chamberlain of Ohio Township on a warrant dated the first day of ^{April} eighteen hundred and thirty six for one hundred acres of land situate in Ohio Township Beave County but on actual survey found within the settled and convenient lines ~~one~~ ^{1 & ten} hundred ¹ acres and the usual allowance of six pt. C. for roads &c. adjoining lands with Richard Knight on the south John Knight on the West heirs of saml Ewings on the North McGlavin District line on the East. the above is a correct copy from the books of surveys of Beaver County in my office.
