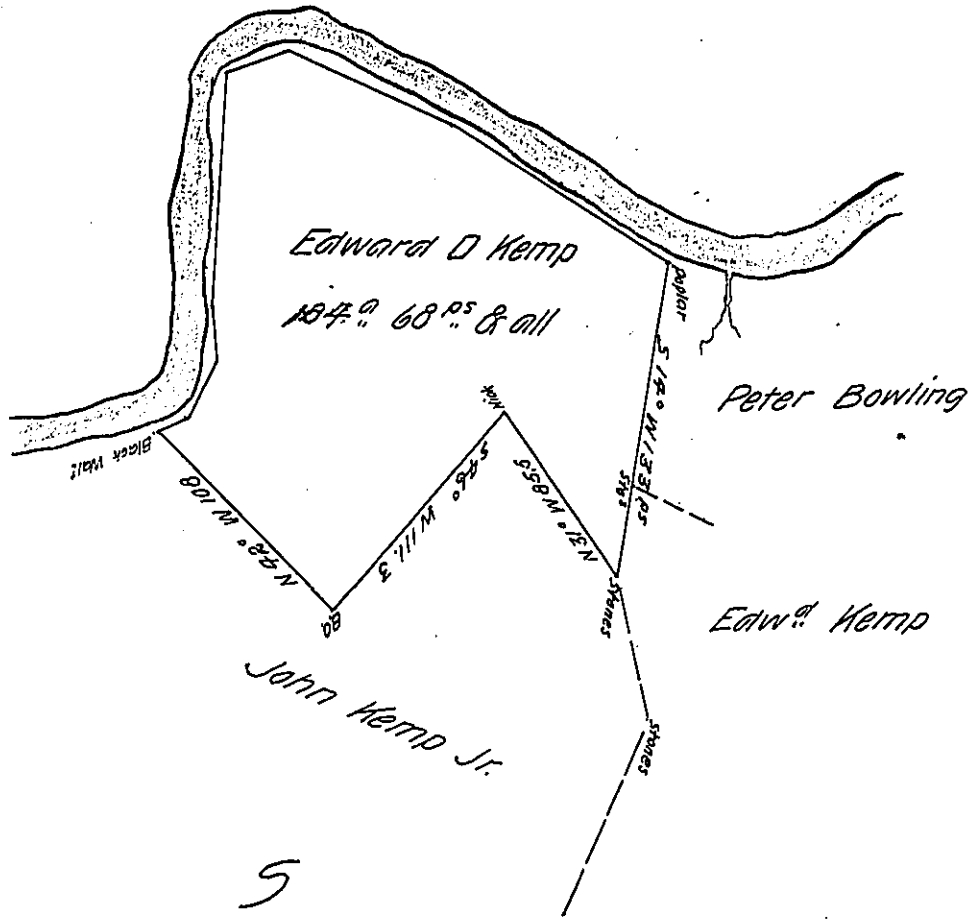


Courses & distances down the river
