



A draft of tract of land situate in Towamensing Township Northampton County originally surveyed unto Peter Strodt by virtue of an application order of survey dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1765 and numbered No. 1161 and which by a computation thereof made by David Shultz <sup>and</sup> was said to contain one hundred sixty six acres three quarters and the usual allowance but which by a resurvey made by George Palmer late deputy surveyor the 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> of Nov. 1800 was found to contain two hundred and forty six acres one hundred and seventeen perches and the allowance of six per cent &c and by me examined and the calculations made and found to be correct I therefore approve the above survey to be correct (Improved land)
