



The above is a draught of a survey made the 14<sup>th</sup> of ~~April~~ <sup>February</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry Knox for 400 acres dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1792 situate on the North West Side of the River Ohio on the East Bank of Big Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to John Rhea called Knox Vill containing four hundred and eight acres and the usual allowance of six p. cent for roads To Daniel Brodhead Esq<sup>r</sup> Jonathan Leet D. S. Surveyor General
