



The above is a draught of a survey made the 15th day of Dec^r 1784 in pursuance of warrant granted to Thomas Lattimore dated the 13th day Oct^r 1784 situate on the waters of the Brush fork of ten mile Creek joining land of Christophe Irish in Washington County Called the Raccoon ford containing three hundred and forty five acres with the usual allowance of 6 P^r cent for roads
