



In pursuance of a Law passed 11<sup>th</sup> April 1799 for the Selling certain reserved tracts therein Named, the instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General there upon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799. Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> Day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot No. 4. of the reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County Containing forty two Acres and one hundred & twelve perches strict measure.
