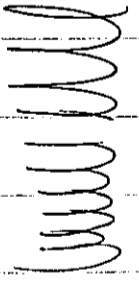


Situate in Shrewsbury township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 25<sup>as</sup> & 149 perches and allowance. Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May A.D. 1819, in pursuance of a warrant for 25<sup>as</sup> granted to George King bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> day of March 1819.

N.B. The improvements at the time of the above, consisted of some land cleared many years ago, with an old dwelling thereon uninhabited, in as much as the roof has fell down and the whole building nearly gone into decay.
