



A draught of a tract of land situate part in Metal & part in Farnet Townships, Franklin County, containing two hundred and twenty-five acres, one hundred and fifty one perches & allowance of six per cent for Road &c. Resurveyed 29th October, 1829, in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented Lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an order of Survey dated 20th June, 1767, No. 4090 granted Joseph Kilgore for 200 acres, joining John Lunds, Robert Wilson, one Moore and Kit Katenny Mountain on Conococheague Creek opposite a large Deer Lick in Potts Valley
