



Situate in Frankston Township Blair County, first surveyed the 14th Oct. 1849, on a warrant granted to Joseph Kemp dated the 23rd January, 1847, it then contained 67 1/2 prs of all^{ce} but interferes with an older survey in name of William Steel and resurveyed the 20th day of October, 1850, in pursuance of an order of resurvey dated the 5th day of March, 1850 and the said interference excluded and other vacant land taken in, to fill the warrant
