



A Draught of a lot of ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town No. 143, situate on the north side of High Street and joining the west side of the Center Square, containing in breadth on High Street sixty feet and in length at the west side Two hundred and forty feet, and at the east side one hundred and eighty five feet, nine inches, Bounded Southward with High Street aforesaid Westward with Lot No. 125. Northward with a twenty feet alley, and Eastward with the Center Square. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 1772. for John Montgomery Esq<sup>r</sup>.
