



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d July following for James Anderson of a certain Lot of Ground, in the Town of Germantown in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General Plan of said Town Number eighty seven. Containing in Breadth Northward and south fifty seven feet six inches and in length East and West two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded westward by Broad Way, Northward by Lot Number eighty six Eastward by River Alley, and Southward by Lot Number eighty eight. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 27th day of September 1772 for John Musser, by warrant dated the 24th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of October, 1905,
