



A draught of a lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle on the North side of High Street in the County of Cumberland, containing in breadth on High Street sixty feet and in length two hundred and forty feet and marked in a General plan of said Town No. 53. Bounded Southward with High Street aforesaid, Westward with Lot No. 45 Northward with a twenty feet alley, and Eastward with Lot No. 61. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 1st day of April, 1772. by Warrant dated the 16th Instant granted to William Miller.
