



A Draught of a tract of land situate on the East branch of the Junkhannoc creek in the Township of Lenox in the County of Susquehanna, adjoining lands of Elizabeth Harris on the North West, and South East of land granted to William Gray. Containing fifty eight acres & fifty eight perches and the usual allowance of six percent for roads &c.

Re surveyed July 2nd A.D. 1840, in pursuance of an order or warrant dated 13th April A.D. 1840, directing me to make a Re survey on the South East line of the tract marked John Higher & John Dowd which I have executed on the ground with care and attention, and thought proper to abandon the line I had previously run (it being on the North West side of a tract in the warranted name of Elizabeth Harris) and establish a line of 20 grains ^{old} forty three perches North West of this abandoned line parallel with the same, there are yet three small improvements on the above.
