



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Moses Levi on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in Northumberland County marked in a General Plan of said Town, Number two hundred and Ninety one, Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Hurtleberry Street afores^d Eastward by River Street, Southward by Billberry alley and Westward by Lot Number two hundred and Ninety - Returned into the Secretary's Office the 29th day of April 1774 for Aaron Levi by Warrant dated the 28th instant

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this ninth day of August 1905.
