



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a certain Lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town Number Seventy nine for William Alexander. Containing in Breadth North and South on Broadway fifty seven feet Six Inches and in Length East and West Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Westward by Broadway aforesaid Northward by Lot Number Seventy Eight, Eastward by River Alley, and Southward by Lot Number Eighty. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 26th day of September 1774 for Thomas Lelan by Warrant dated the 1st of the same Month.
