



By virtue of a Warrant dated the Twenty second day of May 1745, surveyed the Sixth day of July 1745 to George Leibesbarger the above described Tract of Land situate above Macony, Bucks County, containing One Hundred and Fifty seven acres & an half of an acres with Allowance of Six Per Cent.

Edw^d Scull -

The above Survey was Patented to George Leibesbarger the 5th June 1767 thro' a mistake of Edw^d Scull returning the above ^{Survey} joining the person's mentioned above but is since found to be about 12 Miles from Leibesbarger's land, The Patent is Canceled and a New Patent granted by Virtue of the Return fixed on the back of this Survey.
