



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Deerfield (being Part of a larger Tract of the same Name) Situate on the Waters of Paint Creek about half a Mile south westerly from the Creek & about three or four Miles above where the said Creek empties into Stony creek adjoining Lands of Michael Kreider, Mordecai Roberts and Henry Resch in Brothers Valley Township in the county of Bedford containing three hundred and Sixteen Acres and the usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> & 17 Days of May 1774 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benjamin Landis Dated the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1773 by
