



Resurveyed the above discribed tract of land on the 30th. of September 1829 for F. C. Campble Esq^r agent of the Estate of Jonathin Walker Esq^r Deceased (agreeably to the courses and distances made by Charles Lukens Esq. on the 9th. of April 1775 in persuance of a warrant in the name of John Montgomery dated the 27th. of February 1775) in persuance of an order of Resurvey dated the 14. of January 1807, granted to Jonathin Walker, Situate in ovel Limestone Vally Adams Township Lycoming County, bounded as above, containing three hundred and thirty three acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
