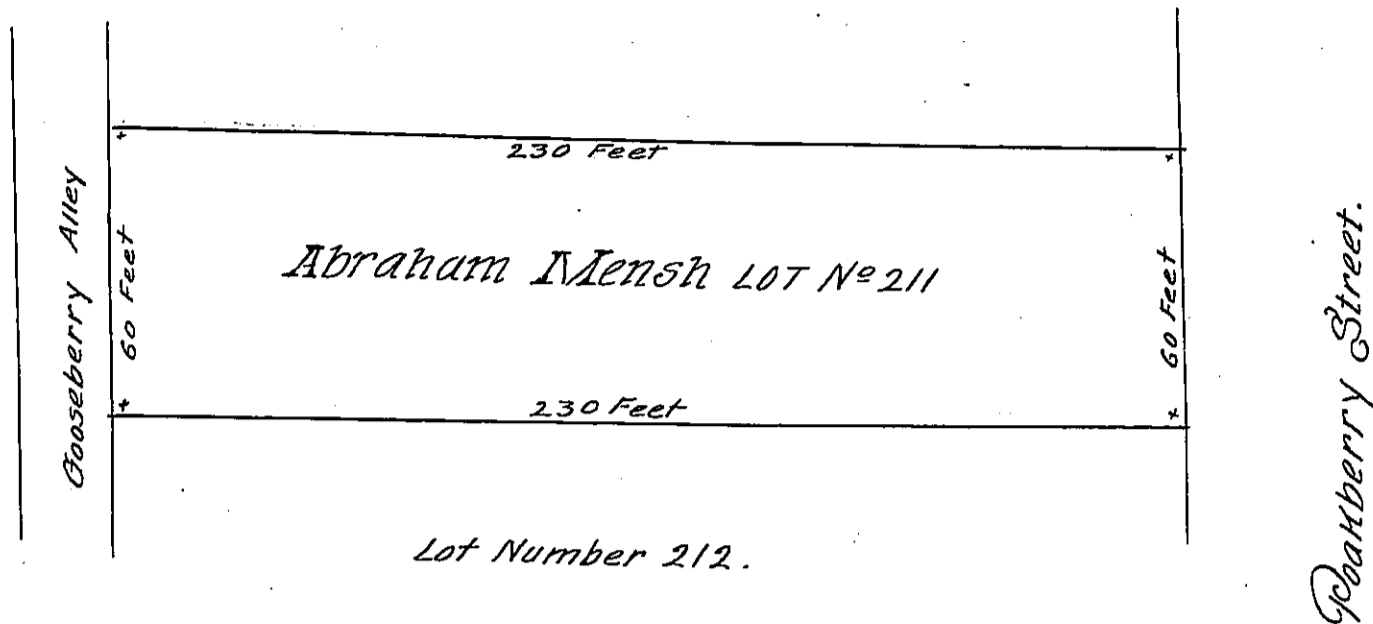


Lot Number 210



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Honim-
 -us Augustine on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury
 in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of said Town
 Number Two Hundred and Eleven, Containing in Breadth East and West
 on the North side of Poakberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North
 and South Two Hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Poak-
 berry Street, Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Ten, North-
 -ward by Gooseberry alley, and Westw^d by Lot Number Two Hundred and
 Twelve, Returned into the Secretary's office the 25th day of March 1776
 for Abraham Mensh by Warr^t dated the 20th same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
 this Sixth day of October 1905.
